Next week is National Anti-Bullying Week, the theme of which is ‘Power for Good’. We will be encouraging the children to think about how they can use their power to help stop bullying. They will be taking part in a range of activities throughout the week to raise awareness of anti-bullying.

Each child will be bringing home a piece of homework linked with this year’s Anti-Bullying Week theme, which will involve creating a super-hero or power to help put a stop to bullying. Two children from each class will have their piece of homework selected to be displayed on the school’s anti-bullying display board; these children will also be awarded a prize in assembly on Friday 18 November.
